CHARGING AND REMISSIONS POLICY

Under the provisions of the 1996 and 2002 Education Reform Acts the governing body has drawn up the following policy.

School Visits: Parents will be asked for voluntary contributions to broadly cover the cost of transport and entrance fees. If a parent does not wish to contribute to the cost, then the child may still take part if the parent wishes. However, parents will be informed on each occasion that the trip will have to be cancelled if enough parents do not contribute. The costs of transport and entrance fees will be funded by the school for Pupil Premium children.

Residential Visits: Board and lodging will be charged for all children. Pupil Premium children will, in addition to having a free school meal entitlement, also be entitled to the remission of charges for board and lodging costs during school residential trips.

School lunches: Parents must keep payments for school lunches up to date and ensure payments are made by the end of each term at the latest. Payments are made via Parent Pay.
