Curriculum Overview	Children will be focussing on the theme of belonging and studying the impact of stereotype prejudice and discrimination and how to change these. They will recognise how differences between people, their beliefs and their personalities affect behaviour and their view of the world. Children will learn the value of their own and others individuality and explore new ideas and perspectives that challenge their own.		Children will explore how war and conflict can affect civilians and soldiers. They will recognise how in times of hardship, no matter a person's identity, people can unite and show camaraderie towards each other. Children will learn the value of compassion and embrace differences. Children will reflect on the importance of a sense of belonging, feeling valued and respected no matter your identity		Children will study the American Civil Rights movement and racial segregation, focusing on the wider causes and effects of racism and prejudice. They will develop an understanding of the importance of resolving conflict fairly and understand the role of non-violent protest in social and political change. They will learn to communicate effectively through a range of media about racial issues to suit subject, audience and purpose.
